

INFO ON THE LATERAL ENTRY AT KL 24'25

Application Deadline: 10th of January 2024 to 15th of April 2024

2-stage selection procedure

The selection procedure for the application for lateral entry in medicine consists of two stages, a selection procedure for the invitation to the admission day in the form of a written admission test (stage 1), and the admission day (stage 2).

Prerequisite for applying for lateral entry

The prerequisite for a positive application for lateral entry to Medicine is proof of a total of at least 180 ECTS from previous studies. It is not possible to apply for a specific entry year. Your entry option will be determined as part of the equivalence review procedure on the basis of your submitted and planned achievements.

Requirements for a lateral entry application for the medicine programme

Proof of a total of **at least 180 ECTS** from previous studies. Of these, <u>up to 50 ECTS</u> can be <u>ongoing</u> <u>or planned</u> at the time of application. These courses, which have not yet been graded, must already be announced as "Planned achievements" as part of the online application (in the period from January to April). The deadline for submitting these certificates of achievement is 12th of July.

Application procedure

- Online application/registration: "Lateral entry medical studies" degree program
- Payment of the processing fee: € 640,00
- Compliance with the stated deadlines

The time of application does not affect the outcome of the lateral entry application.

Possible cases of a refund of the processing fee

Case 1: The requirements for a lateral entry application are not met -> € 390,-

Case 2: For double applications (regular & lateral entry) -> € 195,-

Result of the equivalence check

After the end of the application deadline (April) or - if planned achievements are specified - after the end of the late submission deadline (July), applicants will receive the result of the equivalence check. This information contains the entry option and information about a possibly necessary supplementary examination, which takes place in addition to the admission interview on the day of admission. A <u>DETAILED AND CONDITIONAL STATEMENT</u> about the entry level and (if applicable) the supplementary examination to be taken can be given <u>ONLY AFTER</u> the equivalence check.

Written entrance test (stage 1 of the selection procedure)

In a further step, you will be asked to register for the written admission test in mid-May. Further information on the written entrance test can be found here:

Registration for the admission day on 21.08.2024 (stage 2 of the selection procedure)

The best-ranked applicants from stage 1, who are eligible for admission after their documents have been fully reviewed, will be invited to register for the admission day. The admission day takes place exclusively in person and consists of an oral admission interview and (if required) the written


supplementary examination. For organizational reasons, all admitted applicants will appear in person at our university in the morning for registration and will receive their time slot for the supplementary exam or interview on site. Please plan for the entire day.

In the course of the written supplementary examination, previously defined content is tested which has not yet been completed in the preliminary studies, but which is a prerequisite for the assigned entry option. The learning materials for the content to be completed will be made available in time. Positive completion of the written supplementary examination is a prerequisite for admission to the admission interview on the admission day.

Confirmation of the study place

Shortly after the day of admission, the fixed available lateral entry places can be confirmed. Any remaining lateral entry places still available after completion of the repeat examinations at the KL will be confirmed up to approximately 2 weeks after the admission date.

If the number of applicants exceeds the number of available study places, the Rectorate will decide on the allocation of the available places based on the available documents/written and oral admission procedure.
